HOVON Financial Support for Printing Costs of Your PhD Thesis

HOVON contributes 250 Euros to the printing costs of each thesis that is based on HOVON data and is written by PhD students who graduate at a university in the Netherlands or Belgium.

Requirements:

- 1. At least one chapter of the thesis should include an analysis of a HOVON study or HOVON study data.
- 2. The PhD student should be first author of the chapter. Equally contributing first author is also allowed.
- 3. A member of staff of HOVON must be co-author of the chapter (e.g., statistician, data manager, project manager), with 'HOVON Foundation, Rotterdam, the Netherlands' as affiliation in the publication.
- 4. The student graduates at a university that is affiliated with HOVON. This includes universities in the Netherlands and Belgium. Other universities may be considered affiliated at the discretion of HOVON.

In order to obtain this this contribution, you must:

- 1. acknowledge HOVON for its contribution in a colophon (if the university regulations allow for a colophon);
- 2. include the HOVON logo in one of the first pages of your thesis (if allowed by university regulations);
- 3. send one hard copy of the thesis to HOVON;
- 4. provide a link to the online version of the thesis in the repository of the university library;
- 5. inform HOVON of your position / new job following your graduation.

HOVON will put a link to your thesis on the HOVON website and may post about it on social media.
